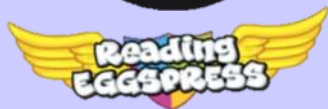
Mathletics is a safe and secure site that children can use to practise their maths skills. Children earn points and credits as they complete activities and your child can collect these towards achieving bronze, silver and gold certificates.

If you are interested in following your child's progress then you can sign up for a parent account by visiting www.3plearning.com/parents. Here you can enter your details and those of your child's Mathletics account. Once you receive your own username and password you can then access the Parent Console.

The school has registered with Reading Eggs and Eggspress, this exciting online program is designed to motivate and excite your child to improve their reading skills. Your child can access Reading Eggs and Reading Eggspress at home using their log-in details to practise what they have learned in class, and you can enjoy the experience with them while viewing their progress online.

You will then receive an activation email, and once you follow the link and sign into your account you can enter your child's username and password to link them to your account.
