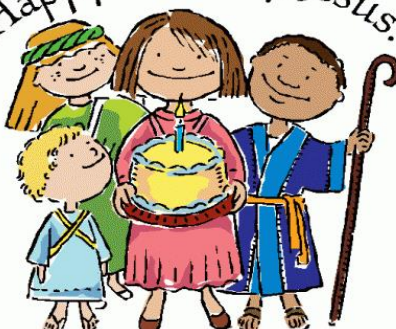
### Christmas Jumper day
