What is the world wide web?

How can you find things online?

Can you point out a hyperlink on this web page?

How did you find this website or web page online? What did you search for? What is the address of this website? All of the web pages in the world connected to each other Knowing the address (URL) of a website or by searching

Words that are unlined or some images. The pointer can change to a hand when you hover over them

The search terms you entered in a search engine or by knowing the address

The URL in the address bar – sometimes starts with https or www
