Welcome back!

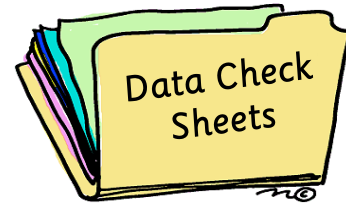
Thank you all for a great start to the new school year with all of the children looking smart in their uniforms and having positive attitudes towards the learning challenges ahead.
