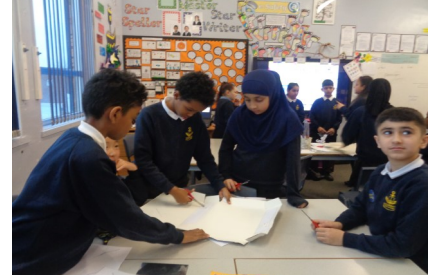


Goodbye Year 6.
