In Year 4 this half term, we have been learning about Romans. The children have had lots of fun making shields which is looking beautiful on our topics display.


It has been lovely having the children back into school; they have adjusted very well and are continuing to keep themselves and their peers safe.

Year 3 and 5


Butlin Street Gates open 9.00–9.10 and 3.30–3.40
