## Year 5 learn about Ancient Egyptians at BMAG.

On Wednesday year 5 visited Birmingham Museum and Gallery as part of the Pharaohs topic we are learning this term.



We spent the morning looking around the Ancient Egyptian gallery where we saw artefacts such as sarcophaguses, amulets, tools, hieroglyphs and even a real mummy! We thought carefully about what these artefacts can tell us about Ancient Egyptian life, culture, architecture and beliefs. We also used our art skills to sketch some of the artefacts.



After lunch, we then took part in a mummification workshop. We learnt about all the steps, tools and people who carry out the process.

### - Safeguarding -

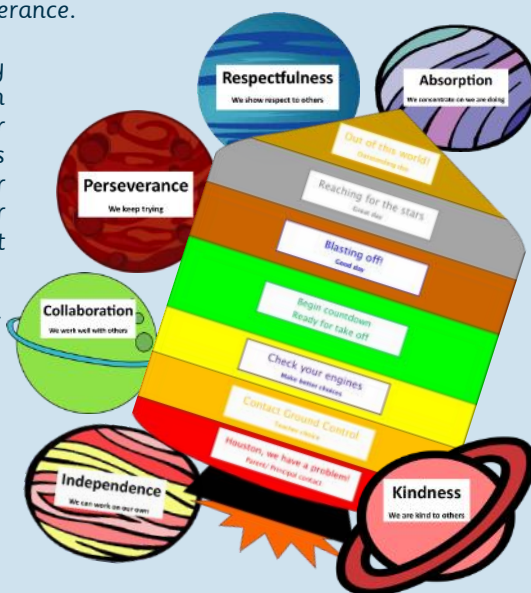
This week's Jigsaw focus is 'Work Well with Others' and is something that the children of St. Clement's do very well. 'Collaboration' is one of the schools promoted learning behaviours and helps the children in valuing and respecting others and problem solving.

The academies learning behaviours work alongside the classroom zone board, 'The Rocket' which is made up of a set of colours. At the top is gold, if children finish their day in gold they get a 'Cosmic Stamp' on their award card. Below gold is silver, then bronze, then green, yellow, orange and finally red. All children start their day in green and move up the rocket by showing positive behaviour or completing fantastic work.

Behaviour not in line with the academies expectations would see children move down the rocket and appropriate consequences given. When the children have reached gold they may then go planet hoping on one of the learning planets - Collaboration, Respectfulness, Kindness, Absorption, independence and Perseverance.

The 'Rocket' is a fun way to engage children in taking responsibility for their actions and helps them to understand their behaviour. The behaviour and welfare of children at the academy is paramount and support can always be given. If you would like further information please see Miss Akers.
