On Wednesday year 5 visited Birmingham Museum and Gallery as part of the Pharaohs topic we are learning this term.

We spent the morning looking around the Ancient Egyptian gallery where we saw artefacts such as sarcophaguses, amulets, tools, hieroglyphs and even a real mummy! We thought carefully about what these artefacts can tell us about Ancient Egyptian life, culture, architecture and beliefs. We also used our art skills to sketch some of the artefacts.



After lunch, we then took part in a mummification workshop. We learnt about all the steps, tools and people who carry out the process.
