

OF KING EDWARD VI

The Schools of King Edward VI have enjoyed a long association with Birmingham Children's Hospital.

Through The Little Hoot, we wanted to raise awareness of our 'Opening Doors' campaign, a strategy which is widening access into our five free grammar schools for children from disadvantaged backgrounds.

We are delighted that following last years 'familiarisation' sessions at our five free grammar schools 133 children were offered opportunities which were not previously open to them. More children from more schools across Birmingham have attended this year's sessions and we are hopeful that these young people will now have the confidence to apply to take the entrance tests for King Edward's selective schools.

It has helped them to develop many art skills plus an appreciation of creativity.
