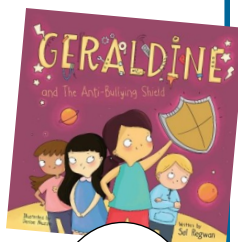

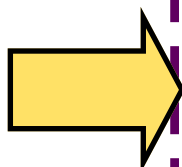

Safeguarding: Anti-Bullying Week

Anti-Bullying Week is coordinated in England and Wales by the Anti-Bullying Alliance and is from 15th to 19th November 2021.



This year's theme is 'One Kind Word'. Children from Nursery to Year 6 have completed work this week on Anti Bullying and spreading kindness. This is not something that we focus on once a year, we ensure that kindness is at the heart of all we do and is celebrated weekly at the academy.

Anti-Bullying work is taught through Jigsaw and through other curriculum subjects, so that children become aware of the impact bullying has and the types of bullying that may take place. At the academy, we have an Anti-Bullying Policy that is shared and a 'child speak' version that the children created, so that they have a clear understanding of Anti-Bullying and know it is not tolerated at the academy.

Article 29 Education must develop every child's personality, talents and abilities to their full. It must encourage the child's respect for human rights, as well as respect for their parents, their own and other cultures, and the environment.
