






Safeguarding: **Drug Taking**



Cannabis can affect your mental health, especially if you take a lot. Smoking with tobacco increases risk from both drugs. Driving when stoned or high can double your chances of having a serious, or even fatal car

England and Wales have a zero-tolerance approach to drug driving. This means you cannot operate a vehicle in a public place while you have illegal drugs in your system. This applies, even if you do not feel impaired.

If you want to stop taking drugs, your GP can tell you about the treatment options and services available. They can also refer you for treatment.
