



SCHOOL UNIFORM

Below you will find our expectations for school uniform. This can also be found in the information booklet that was sent home with reports last week.

Uniform:

- Navy blue jumper or cardigan
- Black or grey skirt or trousers
- White polo shirt or shirt with tie (optional)
- Blue and white check dress in summer
- Black or grey tights or white socks
- Black shoes NO TRAINERS
- Headscarves must be one piece scarves in either plain navy, grey or black (white may be worn in summer)

<u>PE Kit:</u>

- Navy blue shorts or cycling shorts
- Leggings
- Navy blue or black tracksuit bottoms for winter (optional)
- Plimsolls for indoor PE and trainers for outdoor if required
