✓ Garden waste.

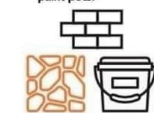


✓ Bigger items: toys, small furniture, household items.

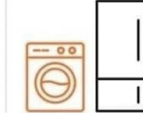


### WE CAN'T TAKE:

From all the staff at St. Clement's, we would like to wish you a safe, peaceful and relaxing summer break and we look forward to welcoming you back in September.

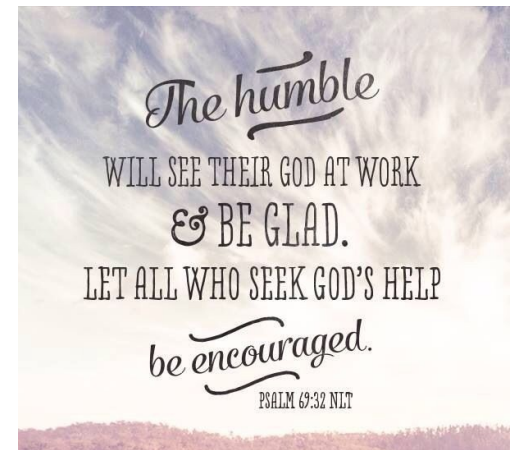

**Article 41: Best law for children applies**

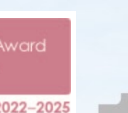
If the laws of a country protect children's rights better than this Convention, then those laws should be used.

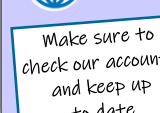

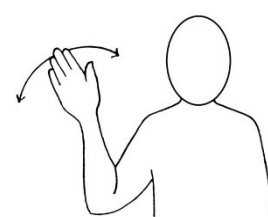

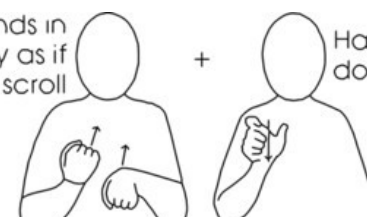

## SCHOOL UNIFORM

Below you will find our expectations for school uniform. This can also be found in the information booklet that was sent home with reports last week.

You can purchase uniform from Trutex either in person or online. In September you will also be able to purchase PE shirts from the school office, should you need to.

### Uniform:

- Navy blue jumper or cardigan
- Black or grey skirt or trousers
- White polo shirt or shirt with tie (optional)
- Blue and white check dress in summer
- Black or grey tights or white socks
- Black shoes NO TRAINERS
- Headscarves must be one piece scarves in either plain navy, grey or black (white may be worn in summer)

### PE Kit:

- Navy Blue Polo Shirt
- Navy blue shorts or cycling shorts
- Leggings
- Navy blue or black tracksuit bottoms for winter (optional)
- Plimsolls for indoor PE and trainers for outdoor if required
