We will be around to give support and teach you new skills that you can use to help your child with their reading.






This week saw the return of St. Clement's Stay and Play. The children enjoyed playing, learning and exploring together.

Come and join in the fun, **every Wednesday**, St. Clement's School Hall, **9am - 10am** or see Miss Akers for further details.














# Important Notices

### Safeguarding - What We Do!

The Trussell Trust partners with local communities to help stop UK hunger.




