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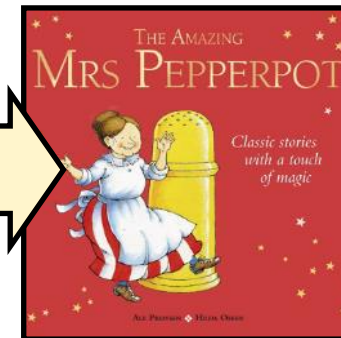
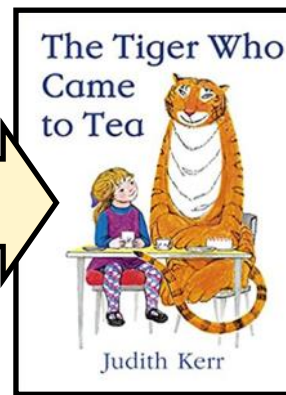
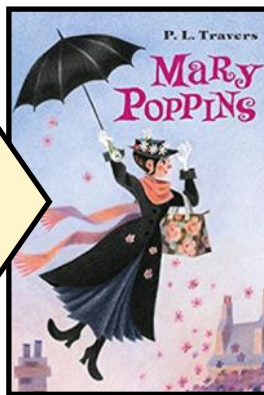

8 A character from one of my favourite books is a twelve year old Viking who ends up with a pet dragon!

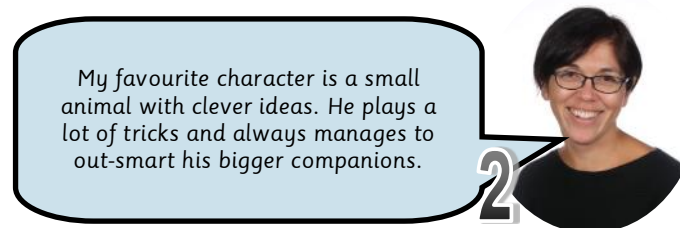
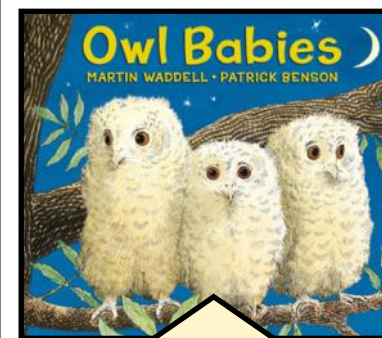

3 The character from my favourite book is a nanny to two small children. She has a bottomless bag and an umbrella that she uses to fly.



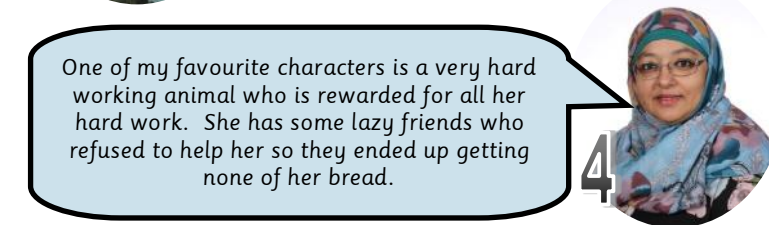
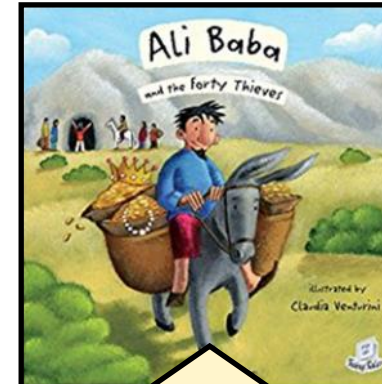
