### Show Kindness Today

1. Let somebody go first.

## UNICEF Rights of the Child

### Article 19: Protection from Violence

Governments must protect children from violence, abuse and being neglected by anyone who looks after them.

### Article 22: Refugee Children

Children who move from their home country to another country as refugees (because it was not safe for them to stay there) should get help and protection and have the same rights as children born in that country.

### Article 38: Protection in War

Children have the right to be protected during war. No child under 15 can join the army or take part in war.



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
