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Jigsaw is a mindful approach to PSHE, which integrates personal, social, health and economic education with a focus on emotional literacy, mental health and spiritual/cultural development. Jigsaw teaches children to become aware of their thoughts and feelings and enables children to talk confidently about their emotions and matters important to them. Jigsaw aims to help children know and value who they really are and how they relate to other people in this



There are six topics within Jigsaw. Being Me in My World, Celebrating Difference, Dreams and Goals, Healthy Me, Relationships and Changing Me. Alongside Jigsaw, Personal Development Sessions are delivered weekly. These sessions look further into mental health strategies, mental ill health, self-esteem, neuroscience, inclusion and many other areas that support children in developing coping skills for the future.

A parent workshop will be held to discuss the Safeguarding, Jigsaw and Personal Development curriculum, so keep a look out for a date and time. Before then, if you would like to speak to someone regarding these lessons, please see a member of the school SLT.

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
