The works will last 10 weeks and should not affect the children, however it may affect parents routes around the school.

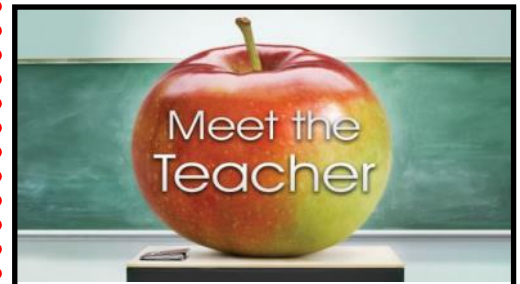

Year 5 have had a very exciting start to their topic on the Egyptians. Last Friday, we dodged the rain to visit the Birmingham Museum and Art Gallery for a workshop on mummification. We began by learning a little about the Ancient Egyptians and then started to prepare a pharaoh by removing his organs and wrapping him tightly in bandages. It was particularly difficult for Eesaa to pull the brain through the nose!

After the workshop, we visited the Egyptian gallery to study real mummies and sketch artefacts such as a mummified cat and a death mask. Everybody learnt a lot and over the next half term we will be building on and using our new knowledge in topic and art lessons.
