Well done to all the children who have been involved in Switch Off Fortnight. I have been really impressed with all the children who have been reminding teachers to switch off lights and other electrical equipment.


We have done this to reduce our energy use so that we have less of an impact on the environment. As an added bonus we will hopefully save the school some money too.
