






Staff, from the Wellbeing Team, have also taken part in refresher training for Mental Health First Aid, which helps to support staff, parents and the wider community.

## Teacher Strike Action: Wednesday 1st March Attention Reception/Year 3 Parents

As you will no doubt be aware, the National Education Union (NEU) has balloted its members on strike action in its on-going dispute with the Government on teachers' pay. There are a number of different teaching unions but at the moment it is only the NEU that has the mandate to strike.

The next planned strike day is Wednesday 1st March 2023. I have consulted with staff and considered which classes we can keep in school with expected staffing levels.

> Currently the following classes only are likely to be affected: <u>Reception, Year 3</u>. On Wednesday 1st March 2023 the children in the above 2 classes should remain at home.

# Head lice – Let's fight them together

A case of head lice has been detected in school. Please check your child's hair and treat if needed.

#### A few pointers:

- Head lice range in size from a full stop to a sesame seed
- It is best to use a head lice comb that's white so the lice can be easily seen
- Live lice remain close to the scalp
- Good lighting is important and so is comfort
- Combing through the hair when wet may make the process more comfortable
- If you find live lice, consult your local pharmacy team and only treat if you find a live, moving louse
